3.1. Bachelor of Information Technology [MIT - 3 Years]



The programme aim is to produce graduates with solid science foundation and skills in computer hardware and software designs, systems administration, database management, network administration and dynamic website and artificial intelligence development. Graduates will be capable IT practitioners of international measure.

Admission Requirements



(A) Direct Entry

Essentials: Mathematics or Physics or Economics and next better done of Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Geography, Biology, Agriculture, Economics, Technical Drawing, Fine Art, Entrepreneurship.

(B) Diploma Entry

Relevant Diploma disciplines include: Information Technology, Computer Engineering, Computer Science, Software Engineering, Information Systems, Telecommunication Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Electronics Engineering, Biomedical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Health Related disciplines, Education (with Mathematics, Physics, or Technical Drawing).

(C) Mature Age Entry

Must have **passed the Mature Age examination with at least a 50% mark**, from a NCHE accredited Centre, NOT more than 2 years ago.

(D) Holders of Higher Education Access Certificate

At least a **Credit** in Higher Education Access Certificate (in Physical Sciences) from Muni University or any recognized University.

3.2. Bachelor of Information Systems [ISM- 3 Years]



The programme is designed to train and produce IS professionals with a mix of knowledge, practical skills and experiences in the use and integration (application) of ICT solutions in modern computerized work and/or business processes.



Admission Requirements

(A) Direct Entry

Essentials: Mathematics **or** Physics **or** Economics and next better done of Mathematics Physics, Chemistry, Geography, Biology, Agriculture, Economics, Technical Drawing, Fine Art, Entrepreneurship.

(B) Diploma Entry

Relevant Diploma disciplines include: Information Technology, Computer Engineering, Computer Science, Software Engineering, Information Systems, Telecommunication Engineering, Library and Information Science, Records and Archives Management, Electrical Engineering, Electronics Engineering, Biomedical Engineering, Agricultural Sciences, Information Management, Mechanical Engineering, Health Related disciplines, Education (with Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Agriculture or Economics).

(C) Mature Age Entry

Must have **passed the Mature Age examination with at least a 50% mark**, from a NCHE accredited Centre, NOT more than 2 years ago.

(D) Holders of Higher Education Access Certificate

At least a **Credit** in Higher Education Access Certificate (in Physical Sciences) from Muni University or any recognized University.

The overall aim of the programme is to train and produce competent, highly-motivated and responsible Teachers who are ready to engage in the production of scientists, science educators, technicians and other skilled human resource to meet the demands of national development.

3.4. Bachelor of Education (Primary) [3 Years- Holiday]



The Bachelor of Education (Primary)- BED-P is designed to train and produce highly motivated teachers, Headteachers, and other caliber of school administrators who are equipped with specialized professional, administrative, and content competencies to improve the teaching and learning outcomes, and general administration in primary schools.



Available subject Combinations

MAT/IS, MAT/P.E, MAT/AGR, EL/SST, EL/RE, & EL/MUS (i.e. Mathematics, Integrated Science, Physical Education, Social Studies, Religious Education, Music Educ.)



Admission Requirements

The entry requirement for the BED (P) programme is a Diploma in Education (Primary), of at least a Credit or Second-Class Lower division from a recognized institution.



Target group

The main target group for BED (P) programme are graduates of Teacher Training Colleges who have attained a Diploma in Education (Primary).



Delivery of the Programme

BED (P) is a three (3) year programme, equivalent to six semesters of lectures and examinations. The lectures are delivered using the long-distance model and face-to-face sessions, conducted during the primary school holidays.



Tuition Fee [per session]

East Africans, including: South Sudan & DRC (UGX: 380,000) session. Non-East Africans (USD: 380).



Prospective careers

The programme is well aligned to the National Teacher Policy (NTP); of training and recruiting graduate primary teachers; In addition to having an enhanced skills-set and knowledge to better delivery of primary school curriculum content, thereby improving learning outcomes and performance. The graduates of the programme have opportunities of progressing with higher education at Masters and Doctoral levels. The graduates of the programme can easily access leadership positions in primary schools as well as serve as Curriculum, Examination experts and Tutors, in different Government and private educational institutions and agencies.

3.5. Bachelor of Early Childhood Care and Education [ECE – 3 Years]



The National Teacher Policy (NTP) 2019, requires that all Pre-Primary Teachers in Uganda should possess a Bachelors' degree qualification. The programme therefore aims to train and produce professional graduates with appropriate theoretical knowledge, pedagogical techniques/practices/skills and values in effective early childhood care and education.



Target Group and admission requirements

(A) Direct Entry Scheme (A' level leavers)

At least Two (2) principal passes in any principal subject at Uganda Advanced Certificate of Education (UACE) obtained at the same sitting or its equivalent, **and** At least Five (5) passes at Uganda Certificate of Education (UCE) obtained at the same sitting or its equivalent.

(B) Diploma holders' Entry Scheme

At least a **Second Class or Credit Diploma** in Education Primary or Early Childhood Education from a recognized institution.

(C) Mature Age Entry Scheme

Must have **passed the Mature Age examination with at least a 50% mark**, from a NCHE accredited Centre, NOT more than 2 years ago.

(D) Holders of Higher Education Access Certificate

At least a **Credit** in Higher Education Access Certificate from Muni University or any recognized University.

Full-time and Holiday (Recess)

3.6. Postgraduate Diploma in Education (PGDE) [1 Year]



PGDE is a “re-tooling” programme for degree holders (persons) without education background who are desirous to become teachers, instructors, lecturers, or educationalists. The aim is to equip participants with the pedagogical knowledge, skills and values required for teaching profession.

The programme objectives are; to equip participants with teaching and instructional practices in designing, delivery, assessment and evaluation of curricula/ academic programmes; critical self-reflection in relation to National and international needs, trends and challenges in pedagogy.



Target group

The programme targets graduates who possess a **Bachelor's Degree (with two teaching subjects)** from a recognized institution, but do not possess the professional teacher qualification and are interested in the education profession.



Delivery of the Programme

The programme lasts for two (2) semesters of lectures and examinations and one Recess Term of ten (10) weeks for School Practice. The programme is implemented using “Blended Learning” approach (i.e., face-to-face and/or online where applicable).



Tuition Fee [per Semester]

East Africans, including: South Sudan & DRC (UGX: 1,150,000), and Non-East Africans (USD: 1,150).



Graduates Prospects

The prospects for the graduates of PGDE range from; classroom teaching, school leadership and administration, to access to training opportunities for higher degrees in the education discipline, thus exposing the graduates to the various opportunities at both private and public educational institution. Further, the postgraduate training also provides opportunities for educational research and consultancy.

3.7. Master of Education (Education Planning and Management [MED-EPM – 3 Years]



Education systems nationally and globally have witnessed significant growth in investment and student enrolment coupled with drastic changes that call for more professional and efficient management systems. The programme therefore aims to produce and/or build capacity of educational planners, leaders, managers, administrators and educationists in educational planning and management.



Target Group

The programme targets holders of at least a Second-Class; Bachelor of Science with Education, Bachelor of Arts with Education, Bachelor of Education (Primary or Secondary) OR Postgraduate Diploma in Education.



Mode of delivery

The programme duration is two (2) academic years, comprising of four (4) Semesters and one (1) Recess Term. The programme is delivered using “Blended Learning” approach (i.e., face-to-face and/or online where applicable) under Open, Distance and e-Learning (ODEL); with 2 weeks of face-to-face and Online lectures for twelve (12) weeks (off-campus). Thereafter, three (3) weeks recaps/remedials and examination.



Graduate prospects

Graduates of Master of Education (Educational Planning and Management) programme have a wide array of career prospects. Typical jobs are, head teachers, administrators, educational planners and managers, College tutors and University lecturers.

3.8. Higher Education Certificate [HEC – 1 Year]



The Higher Education Certificate is the **fourth avenue for admission into Tertiary and University education**. The Programme aims to provide entry opportunity into Diploma or Degree programmes for; persons who do not have appropriate grades/qualifications based on the current national admission criteria. The Higher Education Certificate is **a one Academic Year** (i.e., 2 Semesters) **pre-undergraduate access or bridging or foundational** course/programme.

-  Higher Education Certificate in Humanities
-  Higher Education Certificate in Biological Sciences
-  Higher Education Certificate in Physical Sciences

Target Group and Minimum admission requirements



- (A) Direct entry (UACE).** Uganda Advanced Certificate of Education (UACE) with **one (1) principal pass OR** at least **two (2) subsidiary passes** obtained in principal subjects.
- (B) Vocational Qualifications.**
Vocational qualifications at **level 2** or **level 3** of Uganda Vocational Qualifications framework (UVQF).
- (C) Holder of foreign Qualifications:** Foreign qualification of UACE equivalent with an **overall grade of C**. In addition, foreign students whose studies were not conducted in English shall show proof of proficiency in the English Language.
- (D) Qualifications equivalent** to Uganda Advanced Certificate of Education (UACE) as shall be determined by NCHE or UNEB.
- (E) Ordinary Certificate** in relevant discipline from recognized institution.

Progression (to Diploma or Degree programmes)

(A) Diploma programmes:

A person shall have passed HEC with at least a Class III (Pass).

(B) Degree programme (Bachelors):

A person shall have with at least a Class II (Credit). Target Degree courses can be viewed on the Website.

NOTE:

A candidate who successfully completes a Higher Education Certificate (HEC) can gain access (admission) at Muni University or any other University to any of the following undergraduate Diploma or Degree programmes.

3.9. Bachelor of Nursing Science [NSM: 4 Years]



The overall aim of the programme is to train Nurses for the promotion of all aspects of health, and elevation of professional standards of Nurse-Midwifery practice in the country, region & world over; through studies of behavioural, life and nursing sciences and clinical experience, for effective humane practice and delivery of nursing care leadership.



Admission Requirements

(A) Direct Entry

Essential: Biology and Chemistry

Note: in addition, Direct Entry applicants for MUST have passed English Language with at least a Credit at O' level (UCE).

(B) Diploma Entry

Relevant Diploma disciplines include: General Nursing, Midwifery, Mental Health, Physiotherapy, Anesthesia, Occupational Therapy, Orthopedics, and Clinical Medicine.

(C) Mature Age Entry

Must have passed the Mature Age examination with at least a 50% mark, from accredited Centre, NOT more than 2 years ago.

(D) Holders of Higher Education Access Certificate

At least a Credit in Higher Education Access Certificate (Biological Sciences or Biology and Chemistry) from Muni University or any recognized University.

East Africans, including: South Sudan & DRC (UGX: 1,344,000).
Non-East Africans (USD: 1,344)

3.10. Bachelor of Science in Agriculture [ASM – 4 Years]



The programme is practical-oriented, and aims to train students in the field of agricultural production and management. It embraces both the science and practice necessary for food production, as well as offers students valuable “hands-on” skills in farm management, marketing, and community outreach.

Admission Requirements



(A) Direct Entry

Essential: Two best done of: Biology, Chemistry and Agriculture

(B) Diploma Entry

Relevant Diploma in; Agriculture (Crop & Animal), Agroforestry, Fisheries & Aquaculture, Apiculture, Agricultural Engineering, Environmental Science, Food Science, Mathematics, Education with Agriculture, and Public Health.

(C) Holders of Higher Education Access Certificate

At least a **Credit** in Higher Education Access Certificate (in Biological Sciences) from Muni University or any recognized University.

3.11. Bachelor of Business Administration and Management [BBM – 3 Years]



The programme is designed to train and equip students with robust knowledge and versatile skills-sets and attitudes that suit the needs of the changing business environment. The courses offered in the programme aim at equipping students with, entrepreneurial and managerial skills. The programme provides opportunity for students to select from three (3) specialized areas namely; Accounting & Finance, Management, and Marketing.



Admission Requirements

(A) Direct Entry

Essential: Either Economics or Mathematics or Entrepreneurship, and one next better done of the remaining 'A' level subjects.

NOTE: In addition, Direct entry applicant **MUST** have obtained at least Credit in Mathematics at O' level (UCE).

(B) Diploma Entry

Must possess a Second-Class Diploma (or its equivalent) in relevant areas of Business and Management from NCHE recognized institutions.

(C) Mature Age Entry Scheme

Must have passed the Mature Age examination with at least a 50% mark, NOT more than 2 years ago.

(D) Holders of Higher Education Access Certificate

At least a **Credit** in Higher Education Access Certificate (in Humanities, Management Sciences, or English/Literature) from Muni University or any recognized University.



Tuition Fee [per Semester]

East Africans, including: South Sudan & DRC (UGX: 910,000). Non-East Africans (USD: 910)



Prospective careers

The graduates of the programme have career opportunities such as; Accounts professionals, Entrepreneurs, Audit professional, Office Administrators or Business Managers, Bankers and Microfinance specialists, and Business Planning Consultant, Human Resource Management, Public Relations, Small and Medium Enterprise management among others.

3.12. Bachelor of Economics [ECM – 3 Years]



Economics is a key discipline in decision making in both public and private sectors of an economy. Economics places you at the juncture of social science, business and social policy. This fascinating subject helps explain the behavior of individuals, groups and organizations. The programme is designed to train and produce manpower with thorough understanding of the economic theories, principles, models and techniques used in day-to-day business decision making processes.

Admission Requirements

(A) Direct Entry (UACE)

Essential: Economics or Mathematics, and next done of remaining A' level principal subjects.

(B) Diploma Entry. At least a Second-Class Diploma from a recognized institution.

(C) Mature Age scheme. Must have passed Mature Age Entry Examinations, not more than 2 years ago.

(D) Higher Education Certificate. Must a credit in Higher Education Certificate with a bias in Humanities, Management Science, English/Literature from Muni University or any recognized institution.



Programme Fees [per Semester]

East Africans, including: South Sudan & DRC (UGX: 987,700), and Non-East Africans (USD: 986.7).



Career prospects

The programme opens the student a wide array of employment opportunities in many sectors like; banking, finance, NGOs, Private sector and government.

Typical career options include: Economist researcher/consultant, Financial risk analyst, Market Research Analyst, Business strategist, Compensation and Benefits Manager, Actuary, and Credit Analyst, Financial planner/advisor/consultant, Investment analyst, Policy Analyst, Management Consultant, Portfolio manager, and Business Reporter.



3.13. Postgraduate Diploma in Financial Management [PGDFM- 1 Year]



The program aim is to empower and strengthen capacity of graduates to diagnose financial problems, create solutions and provide relevant financial management advice. It is designed to increase technical and professional knowledge and skills in financial management, accountability, budgeting, auditing and financial monitoring for Organization effectiveness.



Target Group

The target group include: employees with Finance and Non-Finance background in various Government departments/institutions and non-Governmental organizations; Middle and top-level manager positions in corporate Organizations; Tax and debt management officers, employees in Banks, Microfinance institutions and Insurances companies; and Graduates interested in finance and managerial careers/roles.



Admission Requirements

(A) Direct entry

Eligible candidate should possess at least a second class (lower) bachelor's degree in management sciences, social sciences, basic and applied sciences and humanities, obtained from a recognized university.

(B) Indirect entry

Holders and/or members of professional qualifications such as CPA, ACCA CIPS CIM, CIA and other professional qualifications shall be admissible into the PGDFM programme.



Delivery of the Programme

The Postgraduate Diploma in Financial Management takes a period of one (1) academic year; comprising of two (2) Semesters and one (1) Recess semester. The course is comprised of a total of 12 modules.

The programme study time is weekend, and is delivered using "Blended Learning" approach (Face-to-face and Online).



Programme Fees [per Semester]

East Africans, including: South Sudan & DRC (UGX: 1,441,500), and Non-East Africans (USD:1,441.5).

3.14. Bachelor of Science [BSM – 3 Years]



Research and innovation remain key drivers for national development, even more now with transition into knowledge-based economies and societies. The Bachelor of Science program will equip the students with a well-rounded and rigorous background across the core scientific disciplines of biology, chemistry, physics and mathematics.

Admission Requirements

(A) Direct Entry (UACE)

Eligible applicants must have obtained at least two (2) principal passes at UACE, and five (5) passes at UCE obtained at the same sitting.

Essential: Two (2) best done of Physics, Mathematics, Biology, and Chemistry

Relevant: Third best done of Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Economics and Agriculture.

Others: General Paper, Sub-Maths, or Computer Studies

(B) Diploma Entry

A candidate shall be admitted for a Bachelor of Science programme if she/he has at least a Second-Class or Credit Diploma in science-based subjects with a bias in Physics, Mathematics, Biology, and Chemistry from a recognized institution.

(C) Higher Education Certificate

Applicants with a credit in Higher Education Access Certificate with a bias in Physics, Mathematics, Biology, and Chemistry from a recognized institution shall be considered for admission.
