Muni University and Aalborg University officially inked the deal for the Future Environment Engineers for clean Drinking Water in Uganda (FEEDU) project on 6th of December, 2023, all thanks to Rev. Fr. Prof. Odubuker Picho Epiphany and Mr. Lars Pico Geerdsen for paving the way to a water-secure future. The deal will see a demo/plant set at the university for water purification where students will have access to clean water for drinking.

The Deputy Vice Chancellor in charge of Finance and Administration Rev. Fr. Prof. Odubuker Picho Epiphany who welcomed the team to Muni expressed utmost gratitude to them for choosing to partner with Muni University to implement this significant Project.

"In the world of today, collaboration, is a critical aspect of all universities, this is a welcome move" -Rev. Fr. Prof. Odubuker Picho Epiphany, DVC in charge of Finance and Administration.

He revealed that Muni University has had a long challenge on where students can get clean water and a geo technical survey was conducted to identify a source of clean water,

the team managed to get a point to collect the clean water so the idea of setting a demo for water purification resonates well with what the university has planned.

This partnership includes an opportunity for students exchange visit, the idea according to the Danish team will give the students an opportunity to see how they treat water in Denmark, 5 students and 2 staff will be supported from Muni University. This will promote inter-continental cross pollination of ideas.

The partners have promised to come back in November 2024 with 10 Danish students that will be able to interact with MU students.
