PRESS STATEMENT

RESUMPTION OF ONLINE TEACHING

Muni University will resume its online teaching and learning effective Monday, 19th July 2021. This follows the events surrounding the Covid-19 lockdown as announced by HE, the President on 6th June, 2021 for 42 days and the second pronouncement on extension of the lockdown on 18th June, 2021 where all schools were asked to close in a bid to stem the spread of the Covid-19 pandemic.

In effect therefore, our Online lectures will be conducted for all courses/course units that do not require practical (laboratory) and field work and will be delivered in line with the Muni University Open, Distance and e-Learning (ODEL) policy and lectures will be delivered on "MUELE" (Muni University e-Learning Environment). Practical components will be taught as and when conditions allow. Faculties/departments are therefore required to teach the pending recess term courses concurrently with selected Semester II courses. Students are therefore called upon to be part of the online lectures as indicated.

Continue observing the Covid-19 Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs), and be supportive of the changes in the academic calendar.
