International Programmes in Germany 2021/2022

One of the most distinctive features of international degree programmes is that they involve a significant amount of compulsory lectures and courses taught in a foreign language, but the language itself is not the focus of academic study for the programme. Other characteristics of these programmes are the award of an international dual degree in conjunction with a higher education institution abroad, or a compulsory period of study or work in another country for a minimum of two semesters.
