- Must be between 15-35 years of age.
- Have completed O-level (UCE) or equivalent.
- Previous training is an added advantage.
- Young women and young people with disability are specifically encouraged to apply.
- Willing to attend all training and post-training programs.
- Proven refugee status, or nationals living in Arua district, Arua city, Madi Okollo district, Koboko district or Koboko municipality.

How to apply: Interested candidates should;

Either

- Get an application form from Muni University main campus, OPM office or Refugee Welfare Council 1s office, CDO office, LC1 office.
- Fill in the application form with the required evidence including copy of Refugee Identity card or Attestation card or National Identity card for Ugandans.
- Completed applications forms endorsed by the LC1 or Refugee Welfare Council 1 chairpersons should be submitted physically office of the academic registrar, Muni University main campus, or sub-county community to either development office, or camp commandant's office.
