Other pertinent information

- Applicants who applied for 'CSMHTS' and 'CFSHKM' last cohort of October 2023 need not apply for the same, but will be considered under this new cohort.
- "East Africa" include applicants/students from; Uganda, Kenya, Tanzania, Rwanda, Burundi, South Sudan and Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC).
- **Training will commence on 3rd February 2024.** NOTE that the University reserves the right to admit applicants/roll-out advertised programme only when the required number of applicants has been realized.
- University staff and students are also encouraged to enroll for these capacity building trainings.
- Note that the delivery can however be agreed upon between University and participants for large groups.
