PRESS STATEMENT

REOPENING OF THE 2020/2021 ACADEMIC YEAR

Reference is made to the Presidential address of 22nd September 2021 in which all post-secondary institutions of learning were directed to reopen effective 1st November 2021 on condition that all students above 18 years of age, teachers and non-teaching staff are vaccinated against COVID-19.

Accordingly, I would like to welcome you back and inform all students, staff, parents and guardians that the second semester of 2020/2021 Academic Year, begins today, 1st November 2021 with half a day orientation session. Please endeavor to attend.

The first week of the Semester shall be used for completion of first Semester examinations, which were cut short by the Covid 19 lock down of 18th June 2021, as well as filling any gaps that may have emerged during the Online teachings in the lockdown period. The Office of the Academic Registrar will issue a detailed timetable for the Semester.

Applications

Currently, the University is accepting applications for both direct and diploma entries under the private sponsorship scheme. I implore you to inform your networks about this opportunity to become part of the great MU!

For your information, the National Council for Higher Education recently accredited four new academic programs to run at MU. They are; Master of Education Educational Planning & Management, Bachelor of Economics, Bachelor of Science (Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics and Computer Studies) and the Higher Education Access Certificate-Humanities.

Similarly, the Higher Education Students Financing Board (HESFB) selected MU as the Student Loan Application Center for the West Nile region to reduce the challenges faced by majority of the less privileged and less resourced students without IT skills and/or computers, who wish to be supported to apply for the Loan scheme.

The office is situated at the former Muni University Task-force premises, near radio Voice of Life, 100.9 FM, in the Central Division of Arua City. Let's encourage potential applicants to visit that office for the necessary support.

Lastly, I urge you to get vaccinated against COVID-19 and continue observing the Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) issued by the Ministry of Health.
